ACTION ITEMS FROM THE DIRECTOR OF ENGINEERING

ACTION ITEM # 1 – Price Rd Phase II Sanitary Sewer Extension SA-1032, Morrison Rd Sanitary Sewer Replacement SA-1049, Oberlin Ct North Rebuild ST-1056- Award Contract: The Price Road project will offer sanitary sewer to a currently unsewered area along James Road and Price Road, and remove an aging lift station from operation on Oberlin Court. The Morrison Rd project will replace a small section of 8" sanitary sewer along Morrison Rd that is in need of replacement. Oberlin Ct North will be rebuilt from Price Rd to Clemson Ave.

On March 2, 2018, bids were opened and reviewed. The lowest responsive and responsible bidder was KE-Site Company with a bid price of \$523,536 to perform the work which was within 10% of the Engineer's Estimate. We are requesting a 10% contingency to cover any unforeseen construction costs. (see attached for Contract Documents and Bid Summary)

We are respectfully requesting an ordinance to enter into contract with KE-Site Company for the Price Road Phase II Sanitary Sewer Project.

ACTION ITEM # 2 – 2018 Street Program ST-1054 – Award Contract: On March 9, 2018 bids were opened and reviewed. In total we received 5 bids ranging from \$2.9 - \$3.8 million. This year's street program consists of asphalt resurfacing, crack sealing, street rebuilds, striping, and waterline improvements.

Decker Construction was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with a base bid of \$2,997,982.70 which is below the Engineer's Estimate. We recommend to award the base bid and both Alternates (Worman Dr Rebuild & application of a pavement preservation agent for resurfaced roadways) for a total amount of \$3,469,561.07. We are requesting a 10% contingency to cover any unforeseen construction costs. (see attached for Contract Documents, Bid Summary, Street Map Listing)

We are respectfully requesting an ordinance to enter into contract with Decker Construction for the 2018 Street Program.
