## 1163.06 - LIGHTING, STRIPING AND TRAFFIC CONTROL.

- (a) Any nonresidential parking area with ten or more off-street parking spaces and any residential parking area with 20 or more off-street parking spaces shall be illuminated during poor visibility to provide an average intensity of one-half foot candles of light as measured at the parking surface areaprovide for adequate lighting. The illumination value at the property line shall not exceed .5 foot candles when adjacent to single family and 1.0 foot candles when adjacent to any other use. All outdoor lighting shall be constant intensity, and shall be directed, reflected or shielded so as not to be of excessive brightness or cause glare hazardous to pedestrians or drivers, create a nuisance or unreasonably interfere with a neighboring property owner's right to enjoy his/her property.
- (b) Any parking area with ten or more off-street parking spaces shall be striped and the striping maintained in good condition to be clearly visible with lines four inches wide to indicate parking space limits.
- (c) Any off-street parking area shall be marked or posted with such traffic control devices as may be determined necessary by the Director of Public Safety for the protection of operators and pedestrians, including directional arrows, one-way signs, no parking signs and fire lane signs.
