2020 CCTV & SANITARY SEWER CLEANING PROJECT – AWARD CONTRACT

The 2020 clean and camera project includes sewers located in the Gahanna subdivisions of Academy Acres, Academy Woods, Academy Place, Cherry Bottom Gardens, Cherry Run, Cliffside, Crossing at McKenna Creek, Gahanna Heights, Laurel Ridge, Springbrook Farms, The Colony, and Valerio Heights. This project includes televising and cleaning approximately 15 miles of sewer pipe, plus inspection of 399 manholes. Bids for the 2020 CCTV & Sanitary Sewer Cleaning Project were opened on Friday, May 29, 2020. The lowest responsive and responsible bidder is Pipetek Infrastructure Services with a bid of \$227,863.10. To cover any unforeseen project costs, we are requesting a 10% contingency, which would bring the total amount to \$250,649.

We are requesting legislation authorizing the Mayor to enter into contract with Pipetek Infrastructure Services. (Bid Summary and Contract attached). Given recent historic wet weather events, we believe it is critical to move forward with this project as soon as possible to help us to improve our sanitary service for our residents. For this reason, we are respectfully requesting that this project be addressed through Emergency & Waiver.
