

Proclamation

GAHANNA SANCTUARY DAY

September 27, 2020

- WHEREAS: The Gahanna Sanctuary, located at 82 N. High Street in Creekside Gahanna, was in 1838 on Johnstown Road; and constructed in 1895 as Peace Lutheran Church, replacing the original church built
- WHEREAS: The original church was dismantled, and the bricks were used in construction of The Gahanna Sanctuary, which was built at a cost of \$8,200. Originally, the pipe organ was pumped by hand, as electric current was not yet available in the area;
- WHEREAS: Peace Lutheran Church held religious services in the building until 1965, when it was sold to a private owner; and
- WHEREAS: The Olde Gahanna Sanctuary, as it was formerly known, was created in 1981 as a 501(c)(4) non-profit organization to maintain the historic portion of the building;
- WHEREAS: The building was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1987 Tudor-style stained glass windows, and the Gothic Revival-style bell tower; and because of its two significant architectural features: approximately 450 sq. ft. of
- WHEREAS: The Gahanna Sanctuary, as it is currently known, continues to be a center for activities by welcoming worthy community groups with laudable purposes to use the facility free of charge for a variety of important needs; and
- WHEREAS: 2020 marks the 125th Anniversary of the construction of the historic portion of the Gahanna Sanctuary; and
- WHEREAS: Gahanna Sanctuary Trustees have a full day of celebratory activities planned to remember and reminisce about the facility as it once was, and to christen the Gahanna's proud history; and Sanctuary's future as a beautiful and unique event venue that highlights
