Proposed rule:

6.30 Hearing of Visitors:

- 6.31 Visitors that wish to speak before Council must complete a speaker's slip, be recognized by the Chair, state their name and address, and the purpose of their comments. There will be a 3-minute limitation on individual comments. Such time schedule would prevail unless extended by the President without opposition by a Council member. Everyone addressing Council will approach the lectern and state their names and addresses for the record.
- 6.32 Visitors wishing to provide public comment but unable to attend in-person must complete a speaker's slip, or in the alternative, provide their name, address, purpose, and comments via email to the Clerk of Council. Electronic comments are limited to 450 words. Electronic comments will be included as an attachment accessible via a linked file accessible through the approved minutes on the Council webpage.
