1. **Permission to Bid the Creekside Parking Garage - Space Count Replacement**

Franey brought forth request to better communicate the available parking spaces and demonstrate that there is parking at different levels by adding signage to the Creekside parking garage; asking for permission to bid for electronic signage; would add sensors to break the garage into different zones to demonstrate availability; Stinchcomb noted lots of requests from businesses for installations of this kind; Jolley noted huge proponent of better communication and for this installment to garage; garage is a great addition for the residents; fan of counting system and display systems at other shopping centers like Easton; Franey noted ours will have electronic sign for arrows; will not have number of spaces with green lighting; that kind of model is outside of our price range; Jolley noted seeing other systems across the City; supports signage in general as it will aid in better communication. Leeseberg inquired what the estimate for cost would be; Franey replied around \$50,000; Jolley inquired what are the maintenance costs and what is the financing; can we use TIF money

or do we have any left in the Creekside account; Franey replied the maintenance will be part of the bid; money to finance has been carried over from previous years; money left over from projects to the ventilation system will hopefully help pay for the sign additions.
