[ORD-0049-2015](#) TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$5,300,000 OF GENERAL OBLIGATION LIMITED TAX BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, RESURFACING AND IMPROVING CITY STREETS, INCLUDING WHEELCHAIR RAMPS, CURBS AND GUTTERS, SIDEWALKS, STREET LIGHTS, TRAFFIC SIGNALS, AND UTILITY INSTALLATIONS, ACQUIRING REAL ESTATE AND INTERESTS IN REAL ESTATE AND RELATED EQUIPMENT, AND LANDSCAPING AND MAKING SITE IMPROVEMENTS;

AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A NOTICE OF SALE FOR THE BONDS; AUTHORIZING THE PREPARATION AND DELIVERY OF AN OFFICIAL STATEMENT RELATING TO THE BONDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
