## THERE ARE NO ACTION ITEMS FROM THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE

## UPDATE

<u>Hamilton Rd Central</u> - The contractor implemented the planned closure of Clark State Road at Hamilton Road on September 14, 2015 to begin construction of the southern roundabout. The closure is expected to be in place 45 days (weather dependent.) Access will be maintained on Clark State Road to residences and businesses in this area during the closure, but there will not be access from Clark State to Hamilton Road during the planned closure.

Two way one lane traffic will be maintained on Hamilton Road during the closure of Clark State Road. A signed detour route will remain in place during the closure.

The signed detour routes will are as follows:

<u>Clark State Road Eastbound</u> – Eastbound motorists will be directed to follow Havens Corners Road from the intersection of Hamilton and Granville east to Reynoldsburg-New Albany Road and then north to Clark State Road.

<u>Clark State Road Westbound</u> – Westbound motorists on Clark State Road will be directed to follow Reynoldsburg-New Albany Road south to Havens Corners Road and then directed westbound back to Hamilton Road. Motorists should expect and account for additional delays during this closure. Alternate east/west routes that may be considered should include Morse Road and Taylor Road.

During this closure, the contractor will begin construction of the southern roundabout, as well as continue to install waterline on Clark State and Hamilton Roads. Over the next two weeks, the contractor is expected to begin testing and chlorination of the waterline, and begin curb and gutter on the eastern portion of the southern roundabout.

Private Utility Companies have started and will continue the process of relocating power lines and installing new gas lines on Hamilton and Clark State Roads.
