RE: Parks & Recreation - Report to Council for Monday, April 11, 2016

ACTION ITEMS:

We are requesting an ordinance for a supplemental appropriation for \$26,818.62 from the unencumbered general fund to account 101.432.4303 an account created for this project. This supplemental is 100% offset by revenue as we received ODNR's 2016 Boating Safety Education Grant.

These funds will be utilized to buy canoes, kayaks, safety equipment and provide for paddling programs for our citizens. This grant application was authorized by resolution RES-0008-2015. We have verified receipt of these funds electronically with our Finance Department through the OAKS system.

While the grantor has communicated to our staff that the funds would be available later this month, we found out today that the funds were actually deposited on February 18th. These new units are scheduled for use on June 4th of this year for a program.

Looking at the Council meeting schedule, I am requesting an emergency for this action to ensure we can get the new units here in time for their inaugural trip in 2016.

COUNCIL UPDATES

New Hires

Blaine Miskell started March 7 as a full-time Golf Course Supervisor with Gahanna Parks & Recreation. He will be overseeing both the inside and outside operations of the Gahanna Municipal Golf Course. Blaine has worked as a Golf Course Superintendent at Pleasant Valley Golf Course for the past 15 years. He also has previous experience working at a municipal golf course and in construction. Blaine holds an Associate's Degree in Turfgrass Management from Ohio State University – Agricultural Technical Institute.

Brian Gill started March 17 as a full-time Aquatics Supervisor with Gahanna Parks & Recreation. Brian has over five years of experience working in the aquatics field, including his most recent experience as Aquatics Director for the Hilltop Branch YMCA. Brian has also held aquatics positions working for Disney World theme parks and resorts. Brian holds a bachelor's

degree from the Ohio State University in Sports and Leisure Studies and a Masters of Education in Recreation and Leisure Studies.

Summer Hires-almost half way through summer hiring of camp counselors and life guards.

Camp Registration Day was held February 27th, and we saw a 64% increase in the total money to be brought in from that day, including what was left to be billed for installments. Totals were 1308 camp spaces filled, \$210,187 brought in – including installments, and \$86,670 brought in that day.
