<u>Item #1 – Ordinance – Peacewar Inc. DBA Wine Guy Restaurant</u>

We are requesting an ordinance for the Mayor to enter into a Percentage Lease Agreement for a term of three years with Peacewar Inc. DBA Wine Guy Restaurant 101 Mill St., Ste. 105, Gahanna OH, for the use of the pergola immediately north of and immediately adjacent to the Wine Guy Restaurant.

The Landlord shall be entitled to rent in the amount of eight percent (8%) of all food sales generated in and from the lease hold space. There shall be no additional rent.

<u>Item #2 – Motion Resolution – Senior Center</u>

We are requesting a Motion Resolution to authorize the transfer of up to \$5,000 from fund account 101.434.5320 Senior Services Operating Equipment to account 101.434.5596 Senior Services Capital for the purchase of a new divider wall at the Senior Center.

The Senior Center Advisory Board request up to \$5,000 from the Gahanna Parks & Recreation Foundation, Senior Center Reserve to pay for half the cost of the wall. The balance will be paid out of the Senior Services Capital account.
