COUNCIL UPDATES

McCutcheon Road Park

We have received the administrative direction packet for the \$250,000 State Capital Budget appropriation for McCutcheon Road Park. There are two options for receiving the funds. The simplest is to not receive funds in advance, but to be reimbursed as funds are expended on the project. We can utilize the \$300,000 appropriation from last meeting to cover these expenses to submit for reimbursement.

We have scheduled a final community input meeting on September 20th at 6 pm at the Centerpoint Church Barn. At this meeting we will discuss alternative concept masterplans to gain input to arrive at a final masterplan for development of construction documents for use in 2017.
