

People choose the suburbs over city or rural life in an effort to escape issues associated with other ways of life such as noise and odor. It is a fact that chickens produce odors and noise. Odor and noise affect property values. They negatively affect property values. Reduced property values reduces the effectiveness of our local government. Less revenue means the city will not be able to fund all the programs and services needed. I hope the folks in favor of chickens won't complain when road improvements are delayed, park programs are cut, or other services are suspended or cut.

In my opinion, the cons far out way the positives. Therefore, it is my opinion that Gahanna does not need a new chicken ordinance. It should also be noted that the current rules and regulations allow for chickens on certain properties. If folks would like to have chickens then they can locate to an appropriately zoned property and still maintain residency in Gahanna.
