October 2016 Report to City Council

The following report provides an overview of responses and services delivered by the Division of Police for the month of October, 2016:

Emergency Communications:

- → Dispatchers handled 413 9-1-1 calls during the month with an average call/answer delay of five
 (5) seconds or less
- → 2,708 calls for service were dispatched

Patrol Operations:

- → Officers documented 297 criminal offenses in October consisting of the following FBI reportable crimes:
 - 9 burglaries and/or breaking and entering's (B&E)
 - 1 robbery
 - 6 drug-related offenses
 - o 27 thefts from motor vehicles
 - 26 damage to property offenses
 - 12 shopliftings
 - o 22 simple assaults
- → The Division responded to 74 motor vehicle crashes including:
 - 63 classified as property damage only (PDO)
 - 11 crashes involved injuries
 - 0 fatalities (zero fatal crashes have occurred in 2016 year-to-date)
 - 12 crashes occurred on IR-270 during the month of October
- → Patrol officers affected 26 arrests for impaired driving (OVI)
- → 58 residential properties were checked as part of the Vacation House Check program
- → A total of 154 alarm responses (robbery, burglary, medical and duress alarms) were handled during the month including:
 - 106 false alarms with 32 that resulted in billable alarm fees

Detective Bureau:

- → The Division's detectives were assigned 207 offense and arrest reports requiring investigative follow-up or other administrative action
- → 5 forensic search warrants were filed and executed during the month of October
