Kayla,

In response to Mr. Wester's questions:

- 1. At startup, the facility will house approximately twenty (20) to twenty-four (24) residents. Those residents will be equally divided between the women's wing and the men's wing. In order to accommodate the initial population, approximately \$200,000 in upgrades will need to be done.
- 2. Upon full operation, approximately seventy (70) residents will be housed at the facility, equally divided between the women's wing and the men's wing. Access Energy has budgeted \$1,000,000 for total improvements (that number includes the initial \$200,000 in upgrades).
- 3. Although not asked, it should be noted that when fully operational, the facility will employ approximately 100 persons divided among three shifts.
