## Gahanna City Council Safety Committee Meeting

Fire Division Briefing – January 23, 2017

### Operational Updates

- Emergency response runs for the month of December included 839 EMS runs and 154 fire runs for a total of 993 incidents. 83 motor vehicle incidents occurred, 39 of which were on the freeway. There were 59 incidents involving unconscious or unresponsive patients – 13 of which were reported as cardiac arrests. There were 8 significant working structure fires. This is an average of 32 runs per 24-hour shift.
- The Fire Division responded to 11,629 emergency runs in 2016 – 9,774 EMS and 1,855 Fire-related incidents. (10,678 in 2015).
- Peak period Medic 131 will be placed into service mid-February. The final date is pending approval by the Board of Trustees.

### Administrative Updates

- Staffing remains at authorized levels in 2017 and includes provisions for the planned retirement of three personnel in 2017.
- Several major initiatives are underway for 2017 including implementing a Community CPR training program. The goal of the program is to train 4,000-5,000 citizens and high school students annually.
