ACTION ITEMS FROM THE CITY ENGINEER

ACTION ITEM # 1 – Gahanna Codified Ordinance Update - Part 1100-

<u>Planning and Zoning</u>: The shift of the Building and Zoning divisions to the Department of Public Service and Engineering necessitated modifications to Gahanna Code Part 1100-Planning and Zoning. A review panel was formed that included Council office and the Service and Development departments. The panel performed a high-level review of this entire section of code and made changes regarding the shift of divisions, corrected typographical errors and reflected process changes that have taken place.

We have attached a red-lined copy of the code for your review. However, because there are so many pages, we have also attached a summary document. The best use of your time might be to review the summary document and only reference the red-lined version of code if you are confused by something you read in the summary.

As required, revisions to the 1100-Planning and Zoning code have been presented to Planning Commission. A public hearing took place on January 25, 2017 and the Planning Commission has recommended that our revisions be forwarded to Council for approval.

We are respectfully requesting legislation authorizing the code changes to Gahanna Codified Ordinances – Part 1100-Planning and Zoning. (Red-lined version, summary document and RCA attached.)
