- Introductions
- Big Walnut Trail Update (see handout)
 - EMHT plans— delineation by EMHT is complete. Tricia can path be extended to Nob Hill North, to New Albany/Academy Ridge? Jeff No contingency funds available. Mid block crossing will have RRFB for pedestrian safety. Is fencing behind golf course needed for safety? Will be investigated. Anticipating early 2018 construction.
 - Additional public meetings: EMHT will assist Service with public meeting, will contact BTAC when scheduled.
 - Jeff met with Brad Troy Euton, Mike Musser/Columbus, and Shannon Sorrel/Whitehall in Whitehall: met about section 8 BWCT, how to connect to Whitehall and Columbus?
 - Columbus has easement/properties that are owned, Columbus working on connection to Blendon Woods soon.
 - East West interchange on East Johnstown coming up in Gahanna to city limits in city street plans. Columbus has Crumm neighborhood project. Gahanna complete street rebuild to the city limits will include sidewalks and/or trail connections
 - Tricia love to see how to get from Hamilton to the airport, for people that ride the bus. Jeff stated it is a Columbus issue.
 - Musser is in charge of Golf course in Columbus, easement on Hamilton Rd might be feasible.
- West Side Intersection Improvement Open House Update will have another public meeting in April.
- **New Construction**: Sidewalks will be installed on Rocky Fork North between Flint Ridge and Hamilton summer anticipated install.
- Question: Hamilton Rd paving, east side June completion for the entire project. One small section of between OSU and 62/Hamilton connection. Will be built this summer with city funds.

- Gahanna Zoning language recommendations: Planning Commission recommended changes through City Council, will be discussed tonight at City Council Meeting.
