## Big Walnut Creek Updates – Jeff

- Section 4: Rob report: Stage 1 plans complete: met with Stoneybrook church for easement; will be hosting public open house at the church, date to be determined. BTAC assistance will be requested when the meeting is scheduled.
- Section 8: will be next section, goal of P&R to apply for next grant round with Clean Ohio/RTP in next round.

P&R Staffing update—Jeff — Deputy Director second round interviews this week- will be in place soon. Brian Gill promoted to Recreation Superintendent, interviewing for Aquatics Supervisor, to be filled by June 1.

## **Engineering Updates:**

- Hamilton Rd. Infra project update Rob working on Multi use trail now, done by mid-June.
- Sidewalk on Rocky Fork N hope to start mid-May.
- Small trail on Shull Rd. connecting two cul-de-sacs connecting to bike trails on Morse Rd., potentially starting in May
- New Albany roundabout trail under Johnstown to New Albany/Gahanna connection complete.
- QU Tricia connecting Foxboro Pool neighborhood to trail suggest riding sidewalk on east side of Hamilton to roundabout, cross to multiuse trail. ACTION: Take "Trail Ends" sign down near the pool. Maybe ultimately sign anticipating Hamilton Rd. connections north of Morse.
- Tricia: new side path in Whitehall to Whitehall Park can we get a connection from Tech Center along Hamilton (by golf course) to Whitehall Park. Railroad Bridge is a barrier. Brad Westall/City of Columbus is in discussion with Jeff/Rob and Shannon/Whitehall.

- Pedal & Smile Rides update: First one Sunday 4/23: 2 people attended. Will be sharing the
  invitation and map send info to Jeff. Planning Historic Ride in July with Historic Society. Will
  promote rides through City and BTAC.
- Bike to Work day May 19, Tricia leading a group from Veterans Park to Columbus City Hall.
   Leaving at 7am.
- Hamilton Rd. Ribbon Cutting planned, info TBD. BTAC can be involved when being planned.
- YouTube Ride Series: Plan to do some with GoPros/Drones to highlight bike access/safety in Gahanna. TBD project.

• City Website Update: Jeff – Developing a new website: Jeff wants to have BWT easy to view, graphics/highlight on P&R landing page. Digital is the consultant, moving quickly.

East/West Corridors, Small Projects, External connections- Map, Discussion, Next Steps outlined

- Jeff: wants to identify priorities per population, safety, etc. for East/West corridors. How do we bring in neighborhoods that are more densely populated, multiunit/apartments, etc. and connect them to the trail connections to/from them?
- Sycamore Run Park behind new condos to Larry Lane: had time securing easements, one owner is holding out. With Hamilton Rd. connection existing there is less priority for this.
- Small Projects: how do we reevaluate/rerank? **ACTION: Tricia will send out "small Projects" list** to the group to review/refine: will discuss these as time allows after E/W corridor discussion.
- ACTION: East West Corridors: Next meeting, focus on review and refining corridors. Kate will work with Jeff/Rob/GI Joe to get maps for next meeting.
