EXHIBIT A

DESCRIPTION OF ADDITIONAL PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

The Public Infrastructure Improvements include the construction of the following improvements within or outside of the Incentive District that will benefit or serve the parcels in the Incentive District, and all related costs of permanent improvements (including, but not limited to, those costs listed in Section 133.15(B) of the Ohio Revised Code):

- Roadways. Construction, reconstruction, extension, opening, improving, widening, grading, draining, curbing or changing of the lines and traffic patterns of roads, highways, streets, intersections, bridges (both roadway and pedestrian), sidewalks, bikeways, medians and viaducts accessible to and serving the public, and providing signage (including traffic signage and informational/promotional signage), lighting systems, signalization, and traffic controls, and all other appurtenances thereto, including, but not limited to, improvements to (a) Heritage Street, (b) Hannah Farms Court and (c) Suzanne Way.
- <u>Water/Sewer</u>. Construction, reconstruction or installation of public utility improvements (including any underground municipally owned utilities), storm and sanitary sewer projects (including necessary site grading), water and fire protection systems, and all appurtenances thereto, including, without limitation, (a) a water line booster and a water tower serving the Incentive District and (b) wetland mitigation and remediation projects for wetlands within the Incentive District.
- <u>Utilities</u>. Construction, reconstruction or installation of gas, electric and communication service facilities and all appurtenances thereto, including, but not limited to, the installation of fiber optic cable to the Incentive District and along the roadways within and adjacent or leading to the Incentive District.
- **Stormwater**. Construction, reconstruction and installation of stormwater and flood remediation projects and facilities, including such projects and facilities on private property when determined to be necessary for public health, safety and welfare.
- <u>Demolition</u>. Demolition, including demolition on private property when determined to be necessary for public health, safety and welfare.
- <u>Parks</u>. Construction or reconstruction of one or more public parks, including grading, trees and other park plantings, park accessories and related improvements, together with all appurtenances thereto, including, without limitation, improvements to Hannah Park and Headley Park.
- <u>Streetscape/Landscape</u>. Construction or installation of streetscape and landscape improvements including trees, tree grates, signage, curbs, sidewalks, street and sidewalk lighting, trash receptacles, benches, newspaper racks, burial of overhead utility lines and related improvements, together with all appurtenances thereto, including, but not limited to, the specific projects described under "Roadways" above.

- Service Facilities. Design, construction and equipping of service buildings and other facilities necessary or convenient to the operation and maintenance of the forgoing improvements and other public infrastructure improvements benefiting or serving parcels in the Incentive District.
- **Real Estate**. Acquisition of real estate or interests in real estate (including easements) (a) necessary to accomplish any of the foregoing improvements or (b) in aid of industry, commerce, distribution or research.
- <u>Professional Services</u>. Engineering, consulting, legal, administrative, and other professional services associated with the planning, design, acquisition, construction and installation of the foregoing improvements and real estate.
