ITEM #3 - SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL SERVICES (2020-2021 WINTER SEASON)

In the past, the City of Gahanna has plowed approximately 10.23 lane miles of Columbus streets each year. The City of Columbus pays a contracted rate to Gahanna for each lane mile that is plowed. The current rate is \$760 per lane mile for these services during the contract period.

We are respectfully requesting legislation authorizing the Mayor to enter into a one-year contract to provide snow and ice removal services for the City of Columbus for the 2020-2021 winter season.
