MARTIN LUTHER KING Jr. DAY

January 18, 2021

- WHEREAS: Martin Luther King Jr. Day was established on November 3, 1983 by President Ronald for his efforts in the advancement of civil rights through nonviolent activism; and Reagan to celebrate and honor the life and achievements of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.,
