ORD-049-2020

**AMEND** THE CODE OF **ORDINANCES** OF ORDINANCE TO GAHANNA, OHIO: Enacting Section 501.14 Misdemeanor Investigation; Examination of Witness and Evidence of Chapter 501 General Provisions and Penalty
