AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT AMENDMENTS TO TRAFFIC CODE SECTIONS OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA; TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES; TO PROVIDE FOR CODIFICATION; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Gahanna, Ohio is authorized by ORC § 715.01 to adopt ordinances relating to its property, affairs, and local government; and

WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna must be amended to conform with current state law as required by the Ohio Constitution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA,

COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna are hereby amended, adopted, and enacted as reflected in EXHIBIT A, attached hereto and made a part herein, for Part 3 Traffic Sections.

Section 2. The addition, amendment, or removal of provisions in the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970 sections when passed in such form as to indicate the intention of the governing authority of the City of Gahanna, Ohio to make the same a part of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970 shall be deemed to be incorporated in the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970, so that reference to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970 includes the additions, amendments, and removals.

Section 3. The codifier, meaning the person, agency or organization authorized to prepare the supplement to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970, is authorized to exclude and omit any provisions of this ordinance that are inapplicable to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970.

Section 4. Supplementation of Code.

(a) In preparing a supplement to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970, all portions of this ordinance which have been repealed shall be excluded from the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970 by the omission thereof from reprinted pages.

(b) When preparing a supplement to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970, the codifier, meaning the person, agency or organization authorized to prepare the supplement, may make formal, non-substantive changes in this ordinance and parts of this ordinance included in the supplement, insofar as it is necessary to do so to embody them into a unified code. For example, the codifier may:

(1) Organize the ordinance material into appropriate subdivisions;

(2) Provide appropriate catchlines, headings and titles for sections and other subdivisions of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970 printed in the supplement, and make changes in such catchlines, headings and titles;

(3) Assign appropriate numbers to sections and other subdivisions to be inserted in the Codified

Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970 and, where necessary to accommodate new material, change existing section or other subdivision numbers;

(4) Change the words "this ordinance" or words of the same meaning to "this chapter," "this article," "this division," etc., as the case may be, or to "sections _____ to _____" (inserting section numbers to indicate the sections of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970 which embody the substantive sections or the ordinance incorporated into the Code); and

(5) Make other nonsubstantive changes necessary to preserve the original meaning of ordinance sections inserted into the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970; but in no case shall the codifier make any change in the meaning or effect of ordinance material included in the supplement or already embodied in the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970.

(c) In preparing a supplement to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970, the pages of a supplement shall be so numbered that they will fit properly into the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970 and will, where necessary, replace pages which have become obsolete or partially obsolete, and the new pages shall be so prepared that, when they have been inserted, the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gahanna, Ohio, 1970 will be current through the date of the adoption of the latest ordinance included in the supplement.

Section 5. Provisions of EXHIBIT A that duplicate or track State statutes which do not become effective until after the effective date of this ordinance, shall not take effect until such statutes take effect.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage by this Council and 30 days after date of signature of approval by the Mayor.
