WHEREAS, the inspection services awarded by ORD-0144-2002 have exceeded the contract amount on the Morrison Road, Phase 1 project, Improvement No. 769; and

WHEREAS, funds are needed to cover the increased scope of services for these inspection contracts; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide these inspection services in a timely fashion, all for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into amended contract with Evans, Mechwart, Hambleton & Tilton, Inc., 170 Mill Street, Gahanna, Ohio 43230, for Inspection Services for the Morrison Road, Phase 1 project, Imp. #769.

Section 2. That funding in the amount of THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$3,500) is hereby supplementally appropriated from the unencumbered, unappropriated balance in the General Fund, to Account No. 101.145.5541, Capital Projects, Streets, to cover the herein costs.

Section 3. That ORD-0001-2003, passed January 2, 2003, is hereby amended to reflect this supplemental appropriation.

Section 4. That, for the reasons set forth in the preamble hereinabove, this ordinance is declared emergency legislation and shall be in full force and effect after passage by this Council and on date of signature approval by the Mayor.
