TO ESTABLISH THE RATES OF PAY FOR PART-TIME PERSONNEL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2016 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2016; TO REPEAL ORD-0180-2014; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City passed ORD-0180-2014, passed December 15, 2014, addressing part-time employees rates of pay, and wishes to continue to have one Ordinance that governs all part-time employees in both class allocation and pay; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate by this Council for employee morale and continuity of City business to proceed with new legislation for salary provisions, all for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That where not in conflict with the Charter, Ordinances, or lawfully promulgated rules and regulations of the City of Gahanna, the Master Salary Ordinance for part-time personnel of the City of Gahanna, is hereby enacted as noted in EXHIBIT A attached hereto.

Section 2. That the pay and benefits of this Ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2016 except as otherwise noted.

Section 3. That ORD-0180-2014 or any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That, for the reasons set forth in the preamble hereinabove, this Ordinance is declared emergency legislation and shall be in full force and effect upon passage by this Council and on date of signature approval by the Mayor.
