SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - Salt

WHEREAS, additional rock salt for snow removal is needed to take care of any snowfall prior to the new year; and

WHEREAS, use of additional salt will create a need for additional overtime; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative to proceed so there is enough salt, all for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That funding in the amount of THIRTEEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$13,190) is hereby supplementally appropriated from the unappropriated, unencumbered Balance of the Street Fund to the following accounts:

220.330.5117, Overtime	2,600
220.330.5131, PERS	354
220.330.5138, Medicare	236.

Section 2. That funding in the amount of SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY FOUR DOLLARS (\$6,954) is hereby supplementally appropriated from the unencumbered, unappropriated Balance of the State Highway Fund to the following accounts:
