AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION AND WAIVER OF SECOND READING - General Engineering Services

**WHEREAS**, recent vacancies in the Engineering Division has coincided with increased activity in capital and private development projects; and

**WHEREAS**, additional assistance is needed to review private development engineering plans, planning applications, and technical studies; and

**WHEREAS**, this will require a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated and unencumbered balance of the General Fund in the amount of \$150,000 for FY2022; and

**WHEREAS**, administration requests a waiver of second reading due to timing sensitivities related to pending projects and the need for immediate engineering support.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That this Council hereby authorizes a supplemental appropriation in the amount of one

hundred fifty thousand dollars and zero cents (\$150,000) from the unappropriated and unencumbered balance of the General Fund to account number 101.11.450.5210 Engineering Professional Services.

**Section 2.** That the second reading is hereby waived.

**Section 3.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage by Council and on date of signature of approval by the Mayor.
