**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS - General Fund for Risk Insurance Renewal**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gahanna joined Central Ohio Risk Management Association (CORMA) to pool with other central Ohio municipalities to purchase property and casualty insurance through RES-0007-2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the renewal period for CORMA is October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the total projected cost for the renewal is \$323,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Administrative Services requests a supplemental appropriation of \$200,000 to use in conjunction with the remaining risk insurance appropriations of \$140,171 in order to fund the renewal.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That funding in the amount of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is hereby supplementally appropriated from the unappropriated, unencumbered balance of the General Fund (1010) for programs as follows:

*101.06.000.5205 - Finance Contract Services: \$200,000*

**Section 2.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage by Council and on date of signature of approval by the Mayor.
