TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AMENDED AND RESTATED COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA AGREEMENT FOR TAX ABATEMENT FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 600 TAYLOR STATION ROAD AND IS A PART OF COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AREA #1 WHEREAS, property located at 600 Taylor Station Road is a part of Community Reinvestment Area #1; and

WHEREAS, a tax abatement agreement for this particular site was entered into in 2006 with SPND LTD.; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Tax Incentive Review Council that the previous CRA Agreement be amended and restated for the remainder of the original abatement period; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2018, the Gahanna TIRC Board voted to recommend a reduction to 75% with a commitment of creating TWELVE (12) full-time equivalent jobs for the current property tax abatement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the tax abatement agreement with SPND LTD., for property located at 600 Taylor Station Road, is hereby modified as set forth in EXHIBIT A attached hereto and made a part herein.

Section 2. That pursuant to MR-0052-2000 the Director of Development is authorized as Housing Officer to sign this agreement.
