AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - Damage to City Property

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Service and Engineering has received funds from the damage of City property; and

WHEREAS, a supplemental appropriation is requested ,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That funding in the amount of thirteen thousand four hundred twenty seven dollars and zero cents (\$13,427.00) from the unappropriated General Fund (1010) be and is hereby appropriated to account number 1011.0110.5510 - Capital Equipment, Police.

Section 2. That funding in the amount of eight thousand eight hundred seventy six dollars and zero cents (\$8,876.00) from the unappropriated General Fund (1010), be and is hereby appropriated to account number 1011.1400.5300 - Materials and Supplies.

Section 3. That funding in the amount of six hundred sixty six dollars and zero cents (\$666.00) from the unappropriated Streets Fund (2200), be and is hereby appropriated to account number 2201.1000.5300 - Materials and Supplies.

Section 4. That funding in the amount of four thousand fifty two dollars and zero cents (\$4,052.00) from the unappropriated Water Fund (6510), be and is hereby appropriated to account number 6511.1000.5300 - Materials and Supplies.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage by Council and on date of signature approval by the Mayor.
