A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MAY AS ASIAN AMERICAN PACIFIC ISLANDER HERITAGE MONTH IN THE CITY OF GAHANNA

WHEREAS, the City of Gahanna's success as a city includes vital contributions made every day by AAPIs in the areas of government, business, medicine, arts and sciences, education, military, and non-profits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gahanna is proud to celebrate and recognize the cultural diversity woven into the fabric of our community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GAHANNA, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Gahanna City Council hereby recognizes May as Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month.

Section 2. That this Council encourages all residents to join in remembering the history of AAPIs, honoring the sacrifices and contributions made by AAPIs to the success and vitality of our City and nation, and commit to strengthening the bonds of belonging for all that live and work in the City of Gahanna.
